

Igor Jerković is full professor of chemistry at Faculty of Chemistry and Technology and leader of the research group at Mediterranean Institute of Life Sciences at University of Split, Croatia with interest in natural organic compounds research (particularly headspace, volatile and less-volatile organic compounds). He graduated and obtained PhD degree at Faculty of Chemistry and Technology (University of Split) while his master of science title was obtained at University of Zagreb Faculty of Chemical Engineering and Technology.

He was leader of 4 national projects and the co-leader of Biological and Chemical Diversity work package of the Scientific Centre of Excellence for Marine Bioprospecting (BioProCro) and leader of the research group for Centre of Competence for Research and Dissemination of Knowledge in the Field of Nutrition and Health (CEKOM 3LJ). He is member of editorial board of 7 scientific journals and is awarded at university and national level with total of 10 research awards. Professor Jerković reviewed 370 scientific papers and is member of two panels for evaluation of scientific projects in Croatia and Poland and additionally reviewed 6 international research projects. He was invited lecturer at 8 international congresses and mentor or co-mentor of 7 PhD thesis. He published 180 papers in Web of Science Core Collection journals and is listed among top 2% of the most influential scientists according to the citation analysis in Scopus database.
